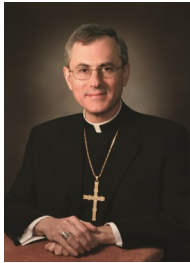

Sacramental Preparation will be offered for all those preparing to receive the Sacraments of

First Reconciliation and First Communion (age 7), and **Confirmation** (under 16).

Preparation is open to children in the separate or public school system. Children receiving sacramental preparation in the Catholic school system should celebrate the sacrament in their home parish. Registration and information on the preparation and will be available at this meeting.

In last Sunday's Gospel we saw God's acceptance of the sinful tax collector. Today's Gospel provides a concrete example of how a change of heart is worked out. Jesus accepts Zacchaeus in his environment and eats with him at his house. This shows Jesus' unconditional acceptance. The wayward tax collector is touched by the love of Jesus and wills to get rid of anything that displaces God's love. Jesus responds by calling him a son of God. Zacchaeus opens his heart to God's invitation and responds with grateful love. What would you and I do if Jesus came to our house unexpectedly? Can we think of a time when we accepted someone exactly as they were and brought about a change in them? Has the reverse ever happened to us? When Jesus was in town he did everything he could to get a better look at Jesus. What are you and I currently doing in our lives to get to know Jesus better?

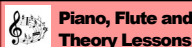
