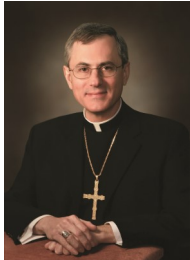

## Week of Prayer for Christian Unity "Justice and only justice, you shall pursue" (Deuteronomy 16:18-20)

Each year the Christian community gathers in prayer with the confident hope of healing all that is divided in Christ's body. We do so to answer Christ's call "All will be one". This year, Bishop Fabbro has asked us to gather with the Anglican Diocese of Huron for a time of prayer and fellowship.

"Together we share a common bond as disciples of Jesus Christ. Yet our unity in Christ is often invisible to the world around us and - at times - to ourselves. The World Council of Churches invites us every year to gather between the Feasts of St. Peter and St. Paul (January 18-25) for a common witness to unity in prayer.

It is our pleasure to host a service for Christian unity at **St. Paul's Anglican Cathedral** in London on **Wednesday, January 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7:30 p.m.** The service of word and song has been prepared by Christians in Indonesia on the theme of 'Justice, and only justice you shall pursue' (Deuteronomy 16:18-20). Several Christian communities in the London area are assisting in the planning and leadership of the worship. The Roman Catholic Diocese of London is sponsoring the reception for fellowship following the service. My dream is that we would fill the Cathedral with Christians of every denomination in the area as a sign of our unity in the gospel and our desire to work together for justice and peace."

The Cathedral will always remain proud – of our active parish family serving more than those who are our parishioners and of the fact we have a beautiful building in the core of our city. Part of that pride involves the church being open on a daily basis. Outside of regular liturgies celebrated, the cathedral is an oasis of prayer in the midst of busyness for people of all ages to come throughout the day to find a safe haven in which to pray and reflect.

When our parish community gathers to celebrate together either on weekdays or weekends we are always safe as there is safety in numbers. However, there are recent incidents that have caused concern. In the past two months these have increased significantly. Our monitors and witnesses confirm that liturgical items in the church have been stolen as well as personal bags in the narthex. The washrooms have been on the verge of being vandalized, the holy water font in the narthex has been destroyed. In January there were seven incidents in nine working days and in October, December and January, incidents that involved assault charges.

The desire to continue to protect persons while providing a place of prayer calls for a decision to be made. Full-time security is cost-prohibitive. Closing the cathedral except for liturgies is an option with the chapel remaining open for prayer. We have decided, during a trial period, to make a graduated monitored response before that needs to become a necessity.

Beginning Monday the only open door to the cathedral will be on the East side. Signage on all the other doors will alert parishioners and visitors alike. On weekdays prior to Mass and/or Confessions the centre double doors facing Dufferin Ave., will be open and remain open for a time following Mass. On weekends, all doors will be open as usual.

I deeply regret having to make this decision but protection of persons and of our sacred space will always be a priority while finding ways to make all feel welcome. If you have any comments or suggestions, please contact me.

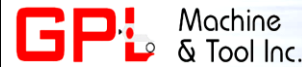

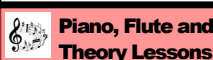
