Dear Parents/Guardians,

We know that many of you have been waiting to have your child confirmed at St. Peter's Cathedral for awhile now. We have decided to move forward with an electronic form of formation that is also abbreviated in the hopes of moving forward with expediency. The Parish will be offering 4 teaching sessions that cover the fundamentals of our faith, and speak directly to the Sacrament of Confirmation.

The following dates are what we can offer for such preparation:

1. September 17th, 7:00 PM: **Who is God?**
2. September 24th, 7:00 PM: **Who am I?**
3. October 2nd, 7:00 PM: **Grace & Sacrament of Confirmation**
4. October 9th, 7:00 PM: **Two-Fold Mission of the Church (your mission)**

Because we are using an electronic means of teaching, we will require a consent form from parents, which is attached to the e-mail or registration documents. Please fill that out. We are also asking that at least one parent be present during the teachings. The reason for involving a parent in the formative process of Confirmation preparation is so that together we can reinforce your child's growth in the faith. The Church teaches that parents have the biggest impact on their child's faith-development, and the Parish and schools are called to supplement your witness and teaching.
