

A huge thank you to all of the volunteers who have come forward to assist with safely re-opening our doors. Without them, we could never have accomplished this. With our change in our Mass schedule beginning the weekend of Oct. 17/18 we will require more volunteers. Ideally we need 15 volunteers for every Mass to assist with the various duties needed: welcoming and screening of our parishioners, seating of parishioners, directing of traffic flow in and out of the Cathedral and at communion, and sanitizing of the Cathedral after every mass. As well we will need volunteers for our baptisms, weddings, funerals, and daily Mass each Wednesday. All safety protocols must be in place every time we open our doors. General Absolution will be offered following each weekend Mass this weekend-Oct. 3/4 and Oct. 10/11. General Absolution will be offered following Wednesday noon Mass on Oct. 7, and Oct. 14. Beginning Oct. 21, individual Confession will be available following the noon Mass each Wednesday until 1:30 p.m. Of course, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is always available by appointment by contacting *Fr. Jim* or *Fr. Peter*.

From the Desk of the Rector

From Pope Francis. Last week Pope Francis released an apostolic letter dedicated to Sacred Scripture. He said that Christians can learn new things from the countless translations of the Bible that exist. "The variety of translations of the Bible in the world today teaches us that the values and positive forms of every culture represent an enrichment for the whole church...The different ways by which the word of God is proclaimed, understood and experienced in each new translation enrich Scripture itself..."

What attitudes are we passing on? It was encouraging to see the support last week for Orange Shirt Day as it put into focus the tragedy of residential schools in Canada. It is good to see we are taking to heart the need for better understanding and awareness.
